

ALPHabet Worksheets & Wall Chart

Are you looking for a fun and easy way to introduce your child to the alphabet? Have fun making an alphabet wall chart. Having the letters visible where they will see them on a daily basis will be an excellent and easy way to review their letters.

Have your child color and trace each letter of the alphabet. Tell your child what the letter name and sound is and have them repeat. Introduce one letter each day while reviewing the previous letters learned.

Help your child learn to write by having them grasp a pencil or crayon, then place your hand over theirs and show them how they trace and write each letter. Eventually they will be able to do it on their own. Tell them the name and sound and have them repeat after you. Review the letters they have learned each day or week.

Directions

Write their name, trace each letter, say the letter name and sound. Then have them color the letter picture with crayons, markers, or water color paint.

Cut each paper in half on the dotted lines. Tape each letter worksheet on a wall in alphabetical order.



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
